Tuition rates reflect a discount of \$500.00 per family for volunteering a minimum of 15 hours per school year. New families and returning families pay a \$125 non-refundable deposit that is credited to the student's financial account.

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES AND FEES

In an effort to prepare families for the financial obligations of private school, we have compiled sample expenses and fees that will be in addition to the school tuition charge per student. Those financially responsible for the CCS account should consider their ability to cover these additional costs. The charges and fees below are for illustrative purposes only and in no way reflect the actual charges that may or may not be added to your student's account. Additional charges may apply for certain programs.

ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL DETAILS

Unless otherwise stated for a specific charge, the due date for CCS incidentals is the 1st of each month following the charge date. Accounts must be kept current. Accounts that become delinquent will result in the withdrawal of the student(s) until the account has been brought current. Under Texas law, private schools may withhold student documents on delinquent accounts.

Families who do not demonstrate a financial ability to afford private school tuition, including additional charges, will be required to pay the CCS tuition charge each semester in advance before the student(s) may attend class.

We recognize that paying tuition is a considerable investment for most families. Investing in a private school education requires careful financial planning. Each family is unique, and CCS seeks to the greatest extent possible, to assist families in affording a quality Christian education. Families are welcome to apply for tuition assistance by following the instructions online. If you are relying on tuition assistance in order to have your child attend CCS, you should make the appropriate preparations in the event your child is not awarded sufficient assistance.
