NOTES FROM THE DIRECTOR

Matilda is a brilliant child with neglectful parents who constantly remind her she was unwanted. School isn't much better, as the cruel headmistress, Miss Trunchbull, rules with fear. Yet, amidst this hardship, Miss Honey offers kindness and support, proving that a nurturing advocate can transform a child's future. Ultimately, she rescues Matilda and adopts her as her own.

As Christians, this story is familiar. Through life's trials, we have an Advocate who comforts, rescues, and adopts us - and His name is Jesus. How fitting that the message of Matilda the Musical aligns with our Christian foundation!

Beyond Matilda's personal story, Roald Dahl's tale highlights the biblical value of life. The doctor in the musical declares, "The most common thing in life is life; and yet every single life, every new life, is a miracle." Matilda's story of a daring circus act reflects this truth: life's miracle surpasses fame or fortune.

"Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, the fruit of the womb a reward." (Psalm 127:3)

"For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb." (Psalm 139:13)

The musical also explores the power of parental influence, whether for good or harm:

"Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it." (Proverbs 22:6)

Matilda is not only intelligent but wise, standing up against injustice. Unlike passive bystanders, she challenges oppression, inspiring others to do the same. Trunchbull sees children as unruly and must be broken into obedience, but Matilda and her classmates refuse to accept mistreatment and revolt. This defiance aligns with Scripture's call to fight for justice:

"Speak up for those who have no voice, for the justice of all who are destitute. Speak up, judge righteously, and defend the cause of the oppressed and needy." (Proverbs 31:8-9)

As you enjoy the humor and music of Matilda the Musical, may you also recognize its deeper biblical truths. May it inspire you to be a "Miss Honey" in someone's life—showing kindness, advocating for those in need, and living by God's command:

"Act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God." (Micah 6:8)
